

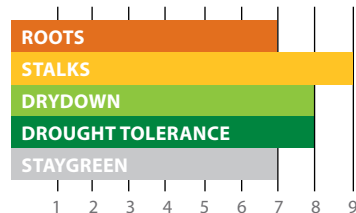

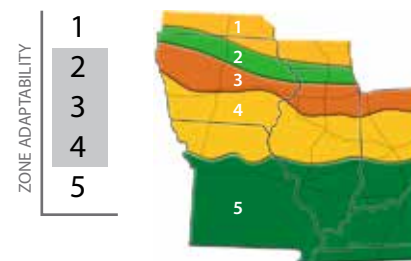
Great hybrid to package with W5138RIB. A solid choice, even for poorly-drained soils.

VG	HEAVY SOILS – HIGH CEC (>18); OM >3.5%; well-drained; dark colored soils.
VG	POORLY-DRAINED – Soils that have the potential to remain saturated for prolonged periods; side hill seeps; gumbo; muck.
